Dear Scholarship Applicant:

Henderson Settlement holds and administers funds that provide scholarships to an individual enrolling in accredited schools for continuing education. This includes certification for trade schools, two and four year college degrees, as well as graduate education.

The scholarship will be awarded under the following conditions:

- **Applicant must be resident of Henderson Settlement service area (See below)**

-Hwy 190 towards Pineville	-----	Wasito Winds Golfcourse
-Rd 3485 towards Middlesboro	-----	Upper Laurel Fork Valley
-Hwy 92 towards Pineville	-----	Former location of Buckeye School
-Mud Creek toward Jellico	-----	Spanning where Mud Crk Rd and Doc Siler Rd are connected by Skaggs Branch Rd
-Hwy 92 toward Williamsburg	-----	The blue bridge crossing the Cumberland River
-Hwy 90 TN toward White Oak	-----	The town of White Oak
-Hwy 90 TN toward Fonde	-----	Just past the town of Fonde up to the strip mine

- **The Scholarship will be awarded annually but disbursement will be divided between the fall and spring semesters**
- **Scholarship checks will be made directly to the school**
- **Applicant must maintain at least a 3.0 GPA to remain eligible for Scholarship**
- **Application must be received by Outreach Office by June 30th with the following supportive materials:**
 - *Statement of need, including how much is needed and for what purpose*
 - *Two letters of recommendation, with one being from a pastor (1st time applicant only)*
 - *Provide evidence of enrollment in accredited school*
 - *Provide most recent transcript*
 - *A list of volunteer and/or community service participation*
