Home Build 2024

"We lost everything! We don't know what we are going to do." Those are scary words to think about, hard to imagine, and devastating to experience. Floods, tornadoes, and fires are a few of the ways people in our area are affected. If you have ever had such an experience then you can understand. If you haven't, have you ever really thought about what you would do? Few people in our area can afford home owners insurance so that heightens the loss even more. This year we had a family lose their home and everything in it due to a fire. After a period of pulling themselves together and finding a temporary housing arrangement they applied for the Henderson Settlement/SOWER home build and were chosen from a list of 13 candidates. To see the excitement and relief on the faces of the parents was very moving. The one statement that keeps ringing in my mind was "Our kids keep asking when can we go home and now we can tell them". We are excited to be able to assist in making that happen but we need your help to do that. Donating to the 2024 Community Home Build is essential to fulfill this year's construction and getting this family "home".

This will be our 41st home build since 1993. All the funding for those home builds have been from the generous donations from churches, groups and individuals who felt the call to give what they could to help. Some of those have even been on site to assist in the construction of those homes. This year we have a bit of a jump start with the initial framing having already been built and transported to Henderson Settlement. However, all remaining costs will depend on donations from folks like you. The past few years the cost of materials has been around \$60,000.00 and we anticipate needing \$50,000.00 this year since we already have that initial framing. Any donation toward this will help. No donation is too small. It all adds up to providing a home to a family with no home to call their own. It seems that each year it is increasingly more difficult to meet the full cost of a home build and we certainly don't want the opportunity to build to end any time soon. Having 13 applicants this year is enough to illustrate the need that exists for this

program.

As I look back on the 40 homes that have been built, it's an amazing Blessing! To see how lives have changed, put on a path to success, and given warmth and safety is an example of how Henderson Settlement can not only bring immediate impact to those in need but also life long impact. Some of these home builds have seen the family prosper and add on to the original build as the family grows. Some have stayed just the same as when they were built because that met the full need. I think of Donnie who had a house collapsing around him and no running water for a long time but now is enjoying his home. I think of Deborah who lost her home to a fire and was living with a daughter. Now she is raising her grandchild in a home built for her. And I often think of "Granny", the elderly lady that set this all in motion with home build number one. Asking for home repairs to a home beyond repair and God setting us on a path we hadn't imagined. Will you help us continue on that path? Hopes and Dreams for the Farm and the Forest

My hopes and dreams as manager of the farm here at Henderson Settlement are so broad and exciting as there are so many options and adventures that we can take.

One thing I would love to see come to past is to see our cattle numbers come up so we can have a revolving door of calves being born and calves ready for the market. That way we can keep cash flow coming into the farm fund on a regular basis as this would allow the farm to contribute to the Ministry. I would love to see all the farm property cleaned up and make as much pasture and hay fields as possible, that way we can rotate cattle all the way up to hard winter and save on feed and hay usage. We need to get all the fences repaired and up to date that way we can move cattle anytime we need to and have fields ready at all times. I want the farm to look presentable to the community and volunteers coming in. I would like to keep some steers on hand to butcher so that way we can keep beef for sale in thrift store at all times and keep the kitchen supplied with meat. We need to play the beef market and price shop to try to get top dollar out of our cattle. Having David around is a blessing. I would love to get the valley back in good farming order.

As Manager of forestry I would love to see several things begin to take place. Planting some trees in places we don't use or can't use for pasture. This will make new forest for possible future wood sales. I would love to get rid of the beavers in the valley and get that back to pasture or turn it to woodland property. Walk all the property lines and property and see if there is things that need to be addressed, like painting the property lines back to be good and visible, make sure none of the timber has been stolen. Clear the forest beds back away from trees that need it to help make them grow better and produce more. Harvest trees that look as if they are dying or going to die, if we can assess them with tractor, haul them off and sale them. We need to place posted and trespassing signs across all properties to show people and unwanted guest that we do not want them on the property. If you have

signs up, then you have lawful reasoning to have them trespassed from the property. If possible try to start a small Christmas tree farm somewhere on the property.

The list is endless as I could sit and write my hopes all day. The main goal and dream of mine is to be in God's will and everything prosper in His Name.
