Welcome to the 2023 project list. For clarification, all project monies are above and beyond the per person registration fee. Feel free to choose any project you like, but please try to think in terms of your group priorities. This is true for both community and settlement projects.

DEFINITION OF TERMS:

LOCATION: We serve an area of twenty (20) radius miles. To keep groups from adopting projects miles apart (and causing difficulties with supervisors) we have assigned "Location" designations so that you can select projects based on their locality. (This is designated only on the Community Projects)

RATING: This refers to skill and/or experience:

1 = no skill/experience: little supervision (cleaning out brush, digging)

2 = some skill/experience: moderate supervision (painting, shingling)

3 = specialized skills (plumbing, electrical, masonry, roofing)

FOR EXAMPLE: Rating: 1,2,3 means "1's" can work WITH 2's AND 3's

Rating: 2,3 means only 2's WITH 3's can do this proj.

Rating: 2 means 2's OR 3's

COST: Materials only, not labor, except in the case of renting a back-hoe, for example, which includes hiring an operator.

** This designation means there is NO MONEY REQUIRED, the materials are either being supplied by the homeowner, have been paid for by someone else, or are being re-used. PLEASE leave these jobs for the groups that are coming without project money. Thanks!

IMPORTANT NOTE: Please indicate your choices in the order of preference and WRITE THE AMOUNT OF PROJECT MONEY AVAILABLE in the space provided.

Number several more projects than you can adopt to provide alternates should someone else already have that/those projects. We will give you available projects in your order of preference and make sure it doesn't go over your dollar limit.

Fees for the projects are to be paid directly to Henderson Settlement and not through the Advance Special. Monies should be sent at least 2 weeks prior to your scheduled VIM work camp date. The listed costs for most projects are slightly higher than actual material costs to cover unexpected expenses. Upon request, we can supply you with an itemization of actual materials used. This request should be made to the work camp director no later than 8:30am Friday mornings of the week you are here.

It is very important that each group be prepared to transport workers from Henderson to the work site in their own vehicles. We have most materials delivered to the job site whenever possible. Any tools the group can bring to use is advisable but we do have tools that can be loaned out. If you have any questions about a particular project please call or email and we will assist you any way we can.
